

RESOLUTION by the Quarterly County Court  
of Weakley County, Tennessee,  
allowing the Highway Department  
to transfer a \$6500.00 deficit  
from the 1962-63 budget to the 1963-64  
budget.

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Highway Department, in order to participate in the Rural Road Program of the State of Tennessee, had to expend extra funds for material and labor in order to repair approximately fifteen (15) miles of roads and to bring them up to the requirements of the State of Tennessee for participation in the Rural Road program; and,

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the Weakley County Quarterly Court that the expenditure of said funds and the meeting of the requirements of the State of Tennessee for participation in the Rural Road Program was to the best interest of said County; and,


WHEREAS, the expenditure of said funds above mentioned has caused a deficit of approximately \$6500.00 in the 1962-63 budget of the Weakley County Highway Department; and,

WHEREAS, it appears to the Weakley County Quarterly Court that the best interests of the County and of the Weakley County Highway Department and the citizens of said County will be best served by transferring said deficit from the 1962-63 budget to the 1963-64 budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUARTERLY COUNTY COURT OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

That the Weakley County Highway Department be and they are hereby authorized to transfer their deficit of approximately \$6500.00 from the 1962-63 budget to the 1963-64 budget and that this resolution become effective immediately upon its passage.
