

APPROVAL OF BRIDGE OF NURSING HOME ROAD

Mr. Dinwiddie presented to the Court that a bridge on the main road from Highway 22 to the Weakley County Nursing Home needed to be rebuilt. He described to the Court the difference in a pre-stress concrete and a treated wood bridge. A pre-stress concrete bridge would last approximately 50 years and cost about \$4,177.25. The treated wood bridge wouldn't cost much less and would last about 30 years. The difference would be in the labor. Esq. Jack Jolley made the motion before the Court that this was a "Special Road" and that the Court should strain a point and go along with Mr. Dinwiddie. Motion was made to pay for the bridge out of Miscellaneous Funds of the General Funds. The motion was seconded by Esq. Richard Pearson. Esq. Cletus Reams asked why come before the Court for appropriating of funds for the bridge: Why not out of the Road Commissioner Fund for the 7th District? Mr. Dinwiddie said the Commissioners would not go along with that expense since it was not included in the budget for 1967. Judge Wheeling asked for a roll call vote.

In answer to the roll call vote of the Court on the foregoing motion, Fifty-One voted in favor of, W. E. McClain voted Present, and R. K. Dinning and Roland Dinning, Absent.
