

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Board of Education did at a meeting on the 25th day of September, 1968, pass a motion and make the same a recommendation to the Weakley County Quarterly Court which motion and recommendation is as follows:

RESOLUTION

That the Weakley County Board of Education recommends to the Quarterly Court that the below listed additions, alterations, and new construction be performed to the listed buildings as soon as possible and the Court take action to finance these projects immediately with the total amount of the recommendation amounting to \$4,250,000.00 as listed below:

Roberts explained the tax structure as to the paying for these school. After much discussion in the Court as to this resolution, Judge Wheeling asked for a Roll Call Vote.

Clerk Charles T. Butts called the Roll for the Resolution. The results was 44 for, 2 against and 1 abstain.
