

RESOLUTION AS READ BY JUDGE E. W. WHEELING--HAROLD T. CONNER, PROPERTY TAX

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Weakley County Board of Education owned a certain tract or parcel of land in the 2nd Civil District of Weakley County, Tennessee, and which property was adjacent to the Martin Junior High School which was formerly the Weakley County Training School, and

WHEREAS, said property was declared by the Weakley County Board of Education to be excess property and was in due time sold to Harold T. Conner who was at that time Principal of the School and an employee of the Weakley County Board of Education, and

WHEREAS, said transfer was made and Harold T. Conner who owned said property for several years, and

WHEREAS, Harold T. Conner recently attempted to sell said property and when the title of the same was checked it was determined that there were delinquent taxes, with interest and penalty on the property which taxes were on the property when it was sold to Harold T. Conner and which he has paid, together with the interest and penalty in the principal sum of \$203.80,

WHEREAS, it appears that it would be inequitable for him to suffer this loss since Weakley County Tennessee derives the benefits from the taxes, interest and penalty which he paid as well as the benefits for the consideration of the sale price of the aforesaid property.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUARTERLY COURT OF WEAKLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, that the Trustee of Weakley County be and he hereby authorized to pay to Harold T. Conner the sum of \$203.80 which represents the taxes, interest and penalty which he has paid on said property purchased by him from the Weakley County Board of Education and to charge the same to the General Fund of Weakley County, Tennessee.
