OLD BUSINESS:

Commissioner Jones made the motion to approve the November 10, 2009 minutes and with a second by Commissioner Bell the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Jones made the motion to not require home improvement contractors to obtain a license to do work within Weakley County and with a second by Commissioner Rich the motion passed unanimously.

Resolution 2010-30

This resolution is to opt out of the Statewide building code standards for one-family and two-family dwellings. Commissioner Bell made the motion to approve and recommend Resolution 2010-30 to the full county commission and with a second by Commissioner Jones the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

Resolution 2010-29

This resolution opposes unfunded local government mandates and additions to local government maintenance of effort requirements. Commissioner Jones made the motion to approve and recommend Resolution 2010-29 to the full county commission and with a second by Commissioner Bell the motion passed unanimously.

Resolution 2010-33

This resolution urges the State of Tennessee General Assembly to oppose SB2938/HB3590. Commissioner Jones made the motion to approve and recommend Resolution 2010-33 to the full county commission and with a second by Commissioner Rich the motion passed unanimously.

Other New Business

Chairman Salmon stated that employee salary increases were uncertain do to the current revenue situation. He called for another meeting set for May 6, 2010, at 4:00 pm to further discuss salary raises.

Having no other business before this committee Commissioner Jones made a motion to adjourn at 4:20 p.m. and with a second by Commissioner Bell the motion passed unanimously.
